MATERIALS:

1 yard of Loop (91 cm)
Book to cover

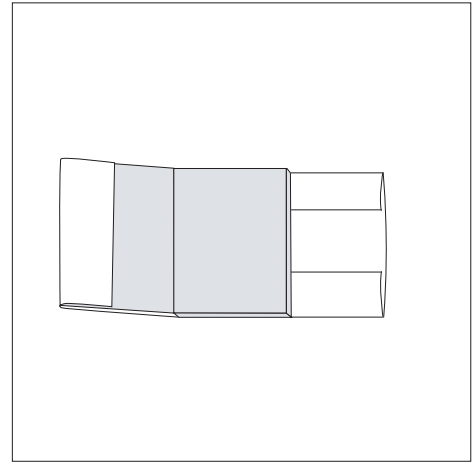
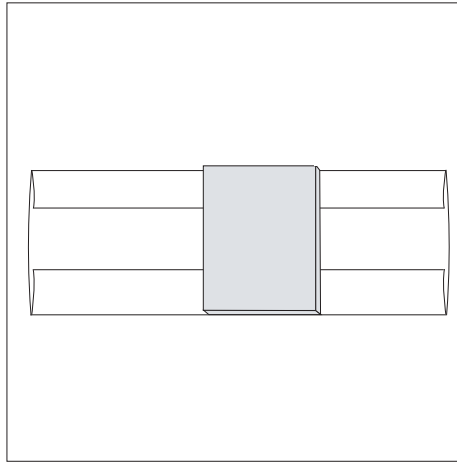
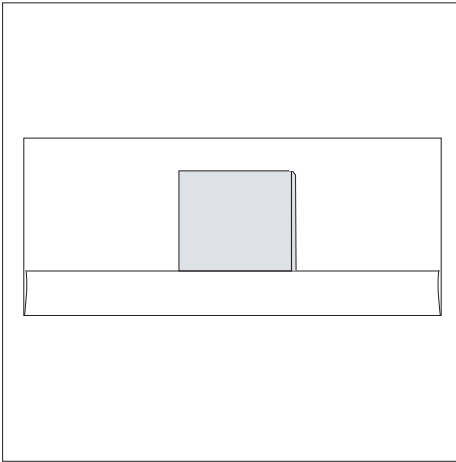
TOOLS:

Scissors
Straight edge / ruler

DIFFICULTY: Easy

TIME: 30 - 45 minutes

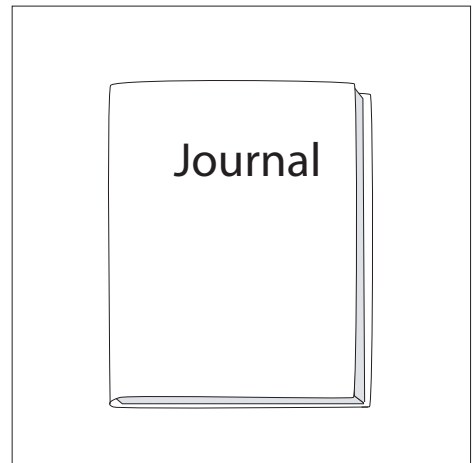
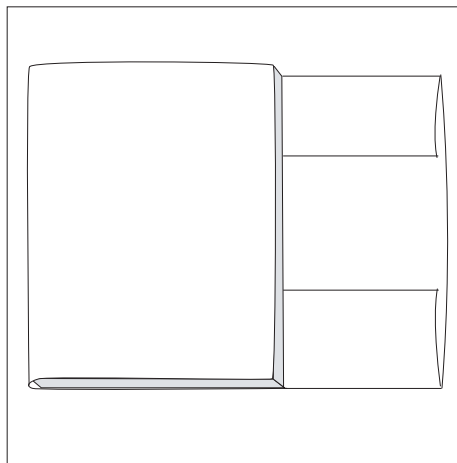
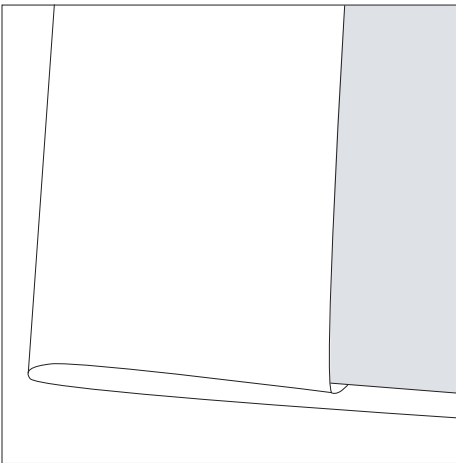
STEP 1 Measure the length and width of the book. Double the width measurement. Add 6 in (15 cm) to the length and new width. Cut Loop to this size to begin.



STEP 2 Place the closed book in the center of Loop. Fold your pre-cut Loop up around the bottom of the book and make a **crease** along the bottom cover. Repeat for the top.

STEP 3 Pull the book out and **fold** Loop along the two creases from step 1. Place the book back onto the material with the spine in the center of Loop.

STEP 4 Open the book and fold the edge of the material around the front cover and **crease**.

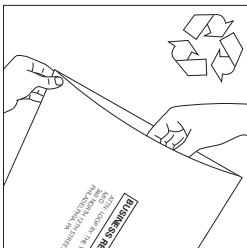


STEP 5 Insert the front cover into the pocket created by the fold. Slide the pocket down over the book until you hit the crease.

STEP 6 Close the book, pulling Loop tight across the cover. Fold the rest of the overlap around the back cover and repeat step 4 in the back.

STEP 7 Label or decorate your cover.

Send us the scraps left over at the end of your project .



RECYCLING
