

Outdoor Pillow

MATERIALS:

1 yard of Loop (91 cm)
Batting (the stuffing)

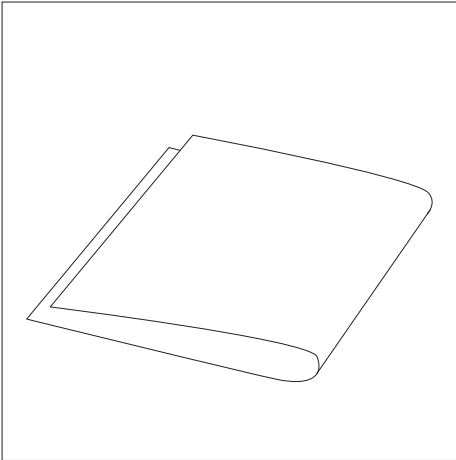
TOOLS:

Scissors
Straight edge / ruler
Sewing machine

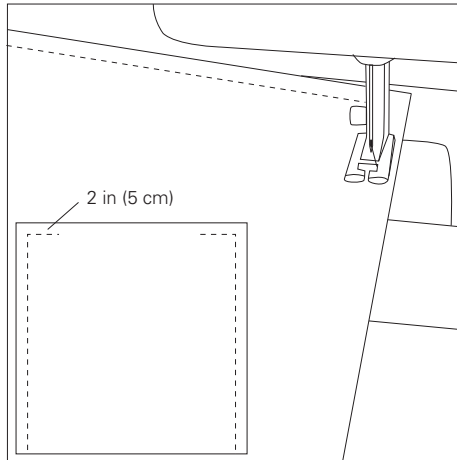
DIFFICULTY: Medium

TIME: 45 minutes - 1 hour

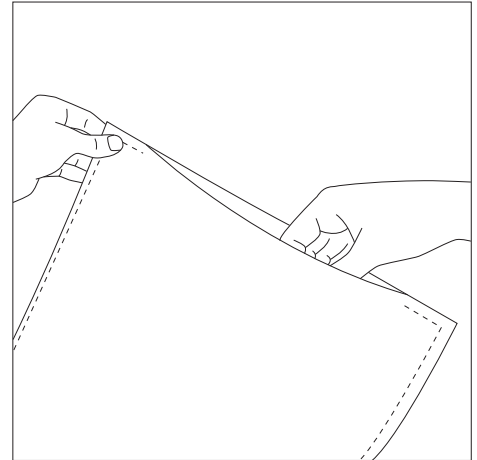
STEP 1 Start with a 20 in (50 cm) by 40 in (102 cm) rectangle of Loop. These dimensions will make a 18 in (46 cm) by 18 in (46 cm) pillow.



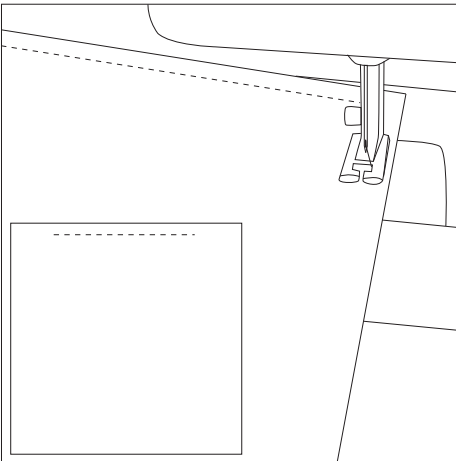
STEP 2 To begin, fold the shorter edge (20 in) up to meet the top edge so that you are left with a square.



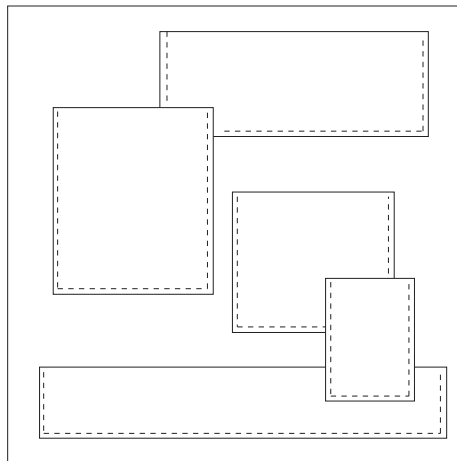
STEP 3 Sew up a side, turn the corner and sew 2 in (5 cm). Repeat on other side so that you are left with an opening to stuff your pillow.



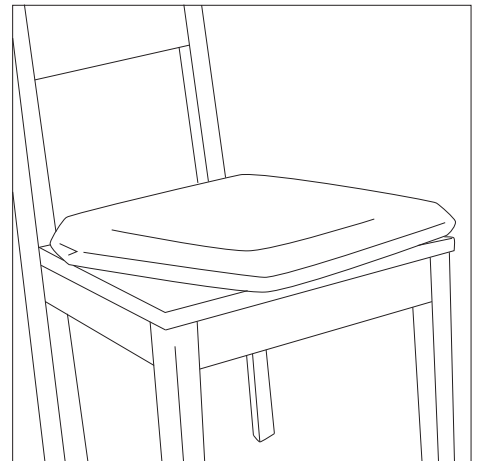
STEP 4 Stuff the pillow with batting to your desired firmness.



STEP 5 Sew the opening shut.

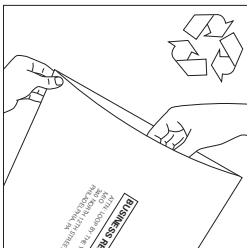


STEP 6 Adjust the starting dimensions for different sized pillows.



STEP 7 Stuff it with foam to make seat cushions.

Send us the scraps left over at the end of your project .
