MATERIALS:

1 yard of Loop (91 cm)
Velcro

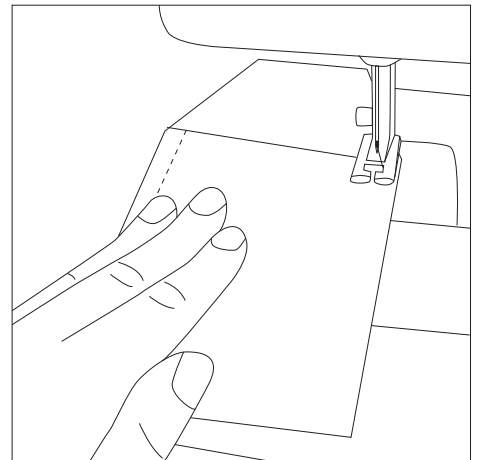
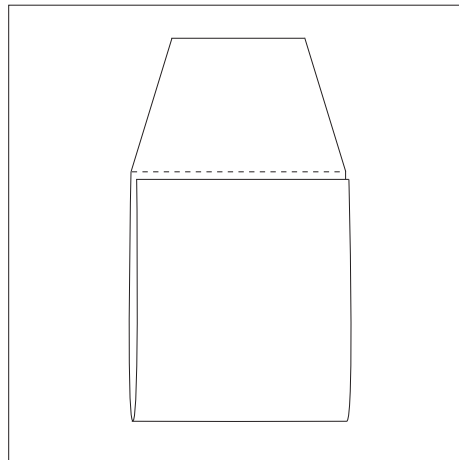
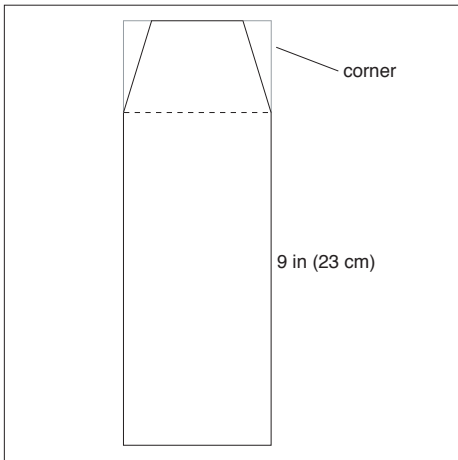
TOOLS:

Scissors
Straight edge / ruler
Sewing machine

DIFFICULTY: Medium

TIME: 30 - 45 min.

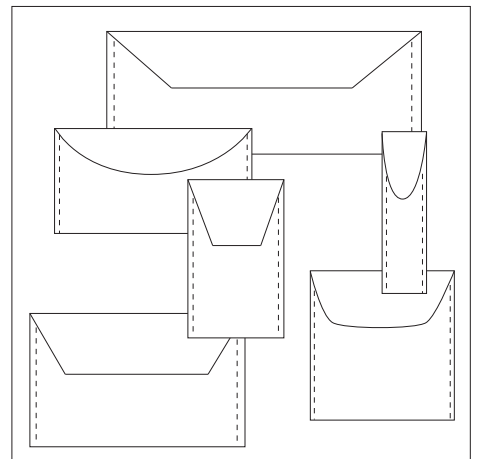
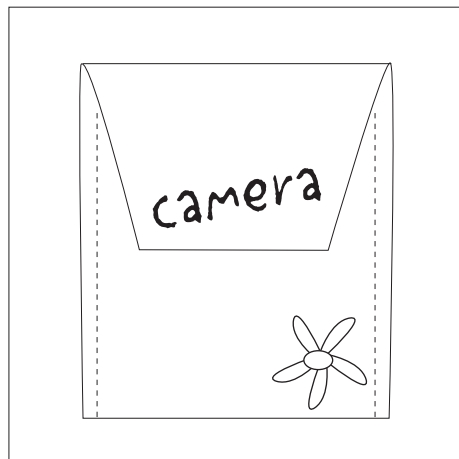
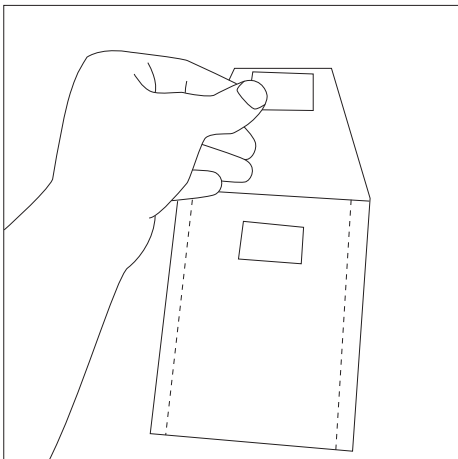
STEP 1 Start with a 4 in (10 cm) by 11.5 in (30 cm) rectangle of Loop. This will make a 4 in (10 cm) by 4.5 in (11 cm) pouch.



STEP 2 Using your ruler, lightly mark 9 in (23 cm) up from the bottom of your rectangle. Cut the corners off the remaining 2.5 in (6 cm).

STEP 3 Fold the bottom edge up to the marked line.

STEP 4 On the sewing machine, stitch the two sides closed. Stitch .25 in (.64 cm) from the edge.

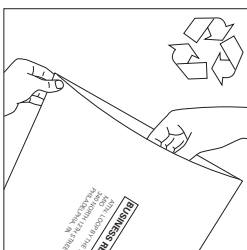


STEP 5 Apply velcro to the top of the flap and the front of the pouch.

STEP 6 Decorate or label your pouch.

STEP 7 Adjust the starting dimensions for a variety of pouch sizes.

Send us the scraps left over at the end of your project.
