Loop

TOOLS:

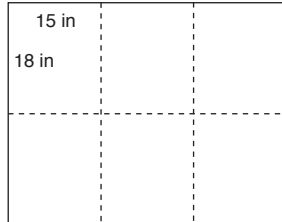
Scissors / utility knife
Straight edge / ruler

DIFFICULTY: Easy

TIME: 30 minutes - 1 hour

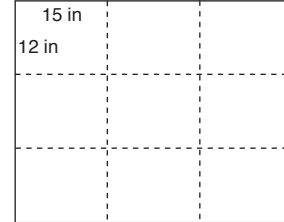
1 Yard (91 cm):

6 placemats
15 in x 18 in
(38 cm x 46 cm)



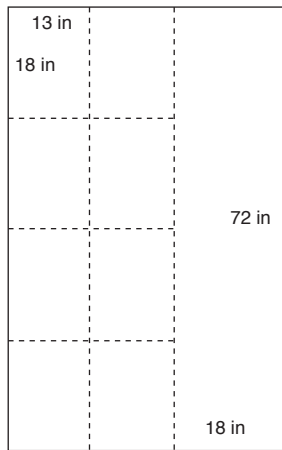
OR

9 placemats
12 in x 15 in
(30 cm x 38 cm)



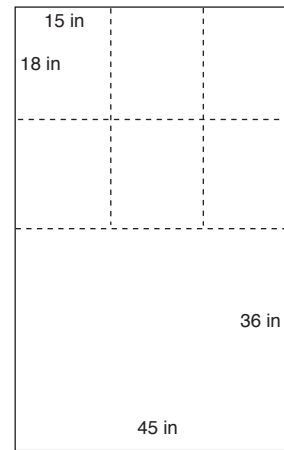
2 Yards (183 cm):

8 placemats
13 in x 18 in
(33 cm x 46 cm)
1 table runner
18 in x 72 in
(46 cm x 183 cm)



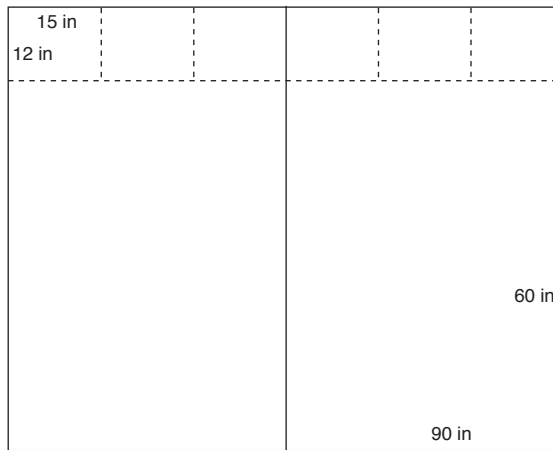
OR

6 placemats
15 in x 18 in
(38 cm x 46 cm)
1 tablecloth
36 in x 45 in
(91 cm x 114 cm)



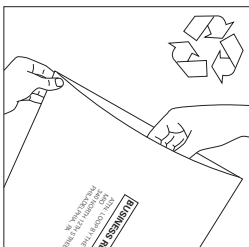
4 Yards (366 cm):

6 placemats
12 in x 15 in
(30 cm x 38 cm)
1 tablecloth
60 in x 90 in
(152 cm x 228 cm)



Start by cutting the 4 yards (366 cm) down to 2 yard (183 cm) pieces. For the table cloth you will have to either sew or tape the seam.

Send us the scraps left over at the end of your project.
